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Smart Tips for Small Businesses: Exit Strategies and Succession Planning

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Entrepreneurs spend most of their life growing their businesses but spare only a hint of their time thinking about their own exits, planned or unintended. Other than personal aspirations, family is a key consideration in succession planning. Are there any candidates from the family who are well prepared for and willing to take the helm? Will the family lose its identity and the natural "glue" after a liquidation event? At times, entrepreneurs face other alternatives such as management buy-in, management buy-out, mergers and acquisitions, which may present both opportunities and challenges at the same time. The talk will offer useful advice on how to build a succession plan early on, with due consideration of exit options.

Roger King is an Adjunct Professor of Finance; Founding Director, Tanoto Center for Asian Family Business and Entrepreneurship Studies and Thompson Center for Business Case Studies at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. His teaching and research interests are entrepreneurship, family businesses and corporate governance.

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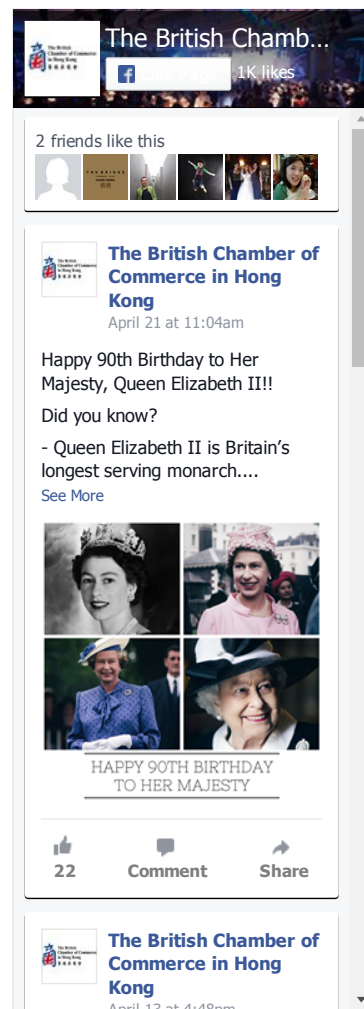
